I understand that the Islamic Institute Ball Hockey League (IIBHL) is a non-contact league with strict rules against rough play. However, I also understand that protective equipment for my child is my responsibility (helmet, gloves, shin guards, athletic protector). I hereby accept full responsibility for any injury to my child in the course of any ball hockey activity organized or sanctioned by the IIBHL.
